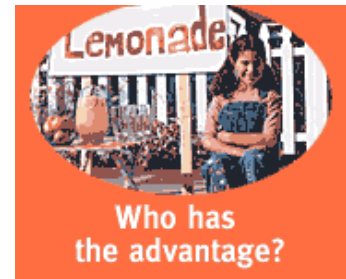
GE Healthcare Converges on Wireless

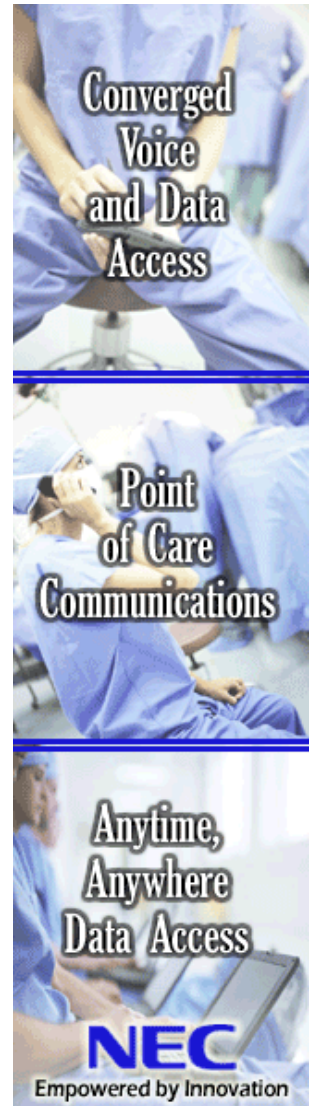
