### **Children's Converges Wireless Tech**

The Children's Hospital, Denver, has purchased wireless technology from MobileAccess Networks, Vienna, Va. Terms of the contract were not disclosed.

The hospital will implement the vendor's Universal Wireless Network system at its new, 236-bed facility in Aurora, Colo. The technology enables access to wireless signals, including Wi-Fi, mobile phone, paging and BlackBerry, over a single, converged network. It's designed to strengthen these wireless signals for both voice and data applications, as well as enable network administrators to control signal distribution among departments and floors.
