Telemetry App Runs on Converged Tech

(July 24, 2006) Waukesha, Wis.-based GE Healthcare has enabled its ApexPro CH telemetry system to run over converged, wireless network technology from MobileAccess Networks.

The Vienna, Va.-based vendor's technology enables access to various wireless signals, including Wi-Fi, mobile phone, paging and BlackBerry over a single, converged network. It's designed to strengthen the wireless signals as well as control their distribution among departments or floors.

GE Healthcare since December has been marketing the technology as part of its wireless enterprise access system. The system is designed to enable health care organizations to use or add various GE Healthcare wireless technologies and services without having to implement separate networks. The new Wireless Medical Telemetry Service will be offered as a module for the enterprise system.
