Expanding the Universal Network

The in-building wireless technology company MobileAccess has expanded its Universal Wireless Network product for 802.11 a/b/g WLAN coverage, added multi-mode fiber support and introduced new management capabilities.

"These enhancements to our Universal Wireless Network enable enterprises to 'springboard' from their existing or planned WLAN investments to a universal solution that overcomes in-building coverage barriers and ensures pervasive coverage and reliable performance for WLAN, cellular, and public safety, among others," says CEO Cathy Zatloukal.

The upgrade, which uses a multi-band antenna, includes a self-configuration capability to compensate for signal loss that occurs on the cables between the access points and antennas.
